ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry Guidelines

- 1. SYLLABUS LEVELS: Bronze is for beginners, Silver is for intermediate, and Gold is for advanced dancers.
- DANCING UP NOT ALLOWED: Couples may enter only one level in the same category. For example: couples entering bronze waltz may not enter silver waltz.
- 3. AGE: Couples may only enter syllabus events in their own age category (determined by the oldest partner).
- 4. **NEWCOMER**: those who have danced **less than 12 months**. Bronze syllabus.
- 5. **OPEN**: Couples may only enter one open event per style. For example: youth can choose pre-champ or champ, juniors can choose junior open or either the youth pre-champ or champ.
- 6. **OPEN COUPLES IN SYLLABUS:** Couples who dance open may not enter below gold or gold 2 in the same style. They may enter the bonus swing events.
- 7. **BONUS**: All couples may enter the bonus events. Bonus is restricted to syllabus figures.
